SNHPC AWARDED BROWNSFIELD GRANT

Brownfields EPA Community-Wide Petroleum Assessment Grant Awarded to The Southern New Hampshire Planning Commission

On May 7, 2009, the Southern New Hampshire Planning Commission (SNHPC) was awarded a \$400,000 Brownfields grant from EPA to be used to inventory and assess potential Brownfields Petroleum and Hazardous Substance Sites within the region's 13 municipalities. The SNHPC is currently seeking proposals from qualified consultants in response to an RFP which is available on the SNHPCs website at: www.snhpc.org.

Deadline for submission of proposals is **August 7, 2009 by 4:30 PM** and must be clearly marked and mailed to David J. Preece, AICP, Executive Director, Southern New Hampshire Planning Commission, 438 Dubuque Street, Manchester, New Hampshire 03012-3546. Qualified disadvantaged (DBE) and women-owned (WBE) businesses are encouraged to submit proposals. Consultants are required to document whether the consultant or subcontractors are DBE or WBE.

A mandatory Pre-Proposal Conference for all firms planning to submit proposals will be held on July 30, 2009 at 12:00 Noon at the SNHPC office, conference room. All questions concerning the RFP shall be addressed at that time.
