

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Southern New Hampshire Planning Commission (SNHPC) is seeking proposals in response to a Request for Proposals (RFP) to retain a consultant with proven experience in environmental site and risk assessment, remediation and corrective action planning, cost estimates and cost control, community outreach, and public presentations regarding site assessment and risk management activities in implementing a three-year, \$400,000 Brownfields Assessment Program grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). This grant was awarded to the SNHPC to assist public and private property owners and municipalities within the region with site assessment and redevelopment planning for both petroleum and hazardous substance contaminated properties. The goal of the *Rebuilding Southern New Hampshire Through Brownfields Investments Program* is to return underutilized properties to public or private uses. A Brownfields Advisory Committee has been formed to assist the SNHPC in meeting this goal.
