The Southern New Hampshire Planning Commission (SNHPC), which was formed under the New Hampshire Statutes in 1966, serves as the coordinating agency for the planning initiatives of thirteen communities in the region. The Commission is also the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the region. The MPO is an organization that conducts transportation planning in a cooperative, comprehensive, and continuous manner. The SNHPC region includes the City of Manchester, and the towns of Auburn, Bedford, Candia, Chester, Deerfield, Derry, Goffstown, Hooksett, Londonderry, New Boston, Raymond and Weare.

SAFETEA-LU requires the MPO, State and public transportation operators to cooperate in preparing a list of projects, including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities, for which Federal funds were obligated for spending during the immediate preceding year. The listing shall be consistent with the funding categories identified in the MPO improvement program (TIP). The listing includes the total amount of funds obligated in the program year and the source of funds. The following pages document the FY2009 Annual Listing of Obligated Projects for the SNHPC region.
