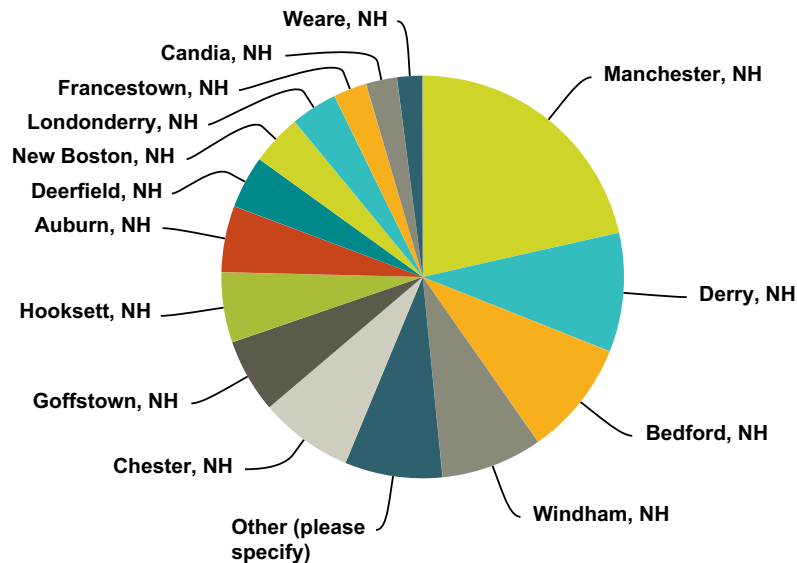

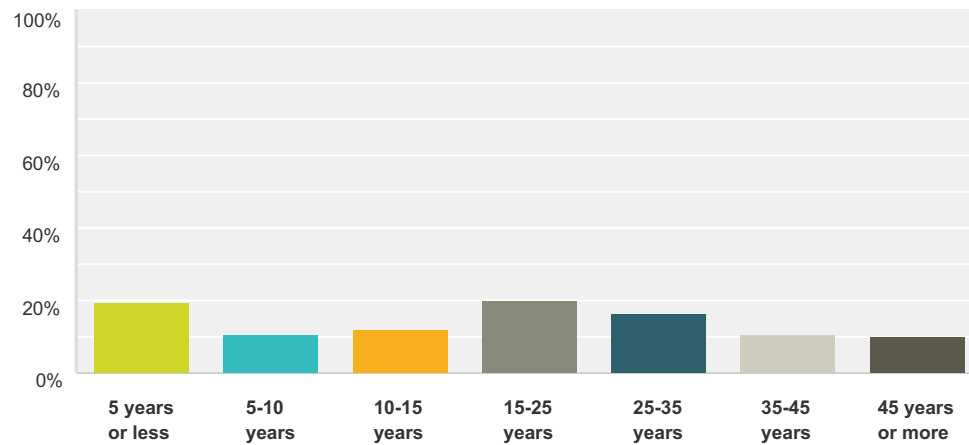

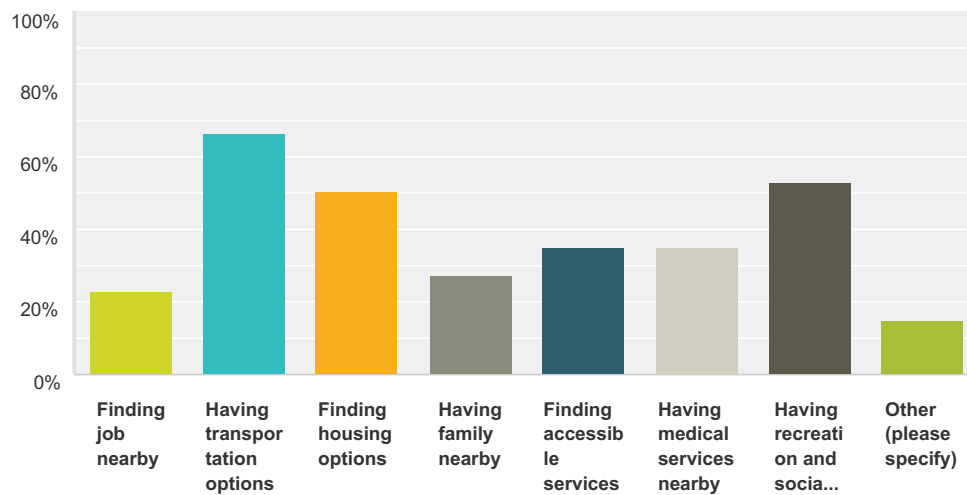

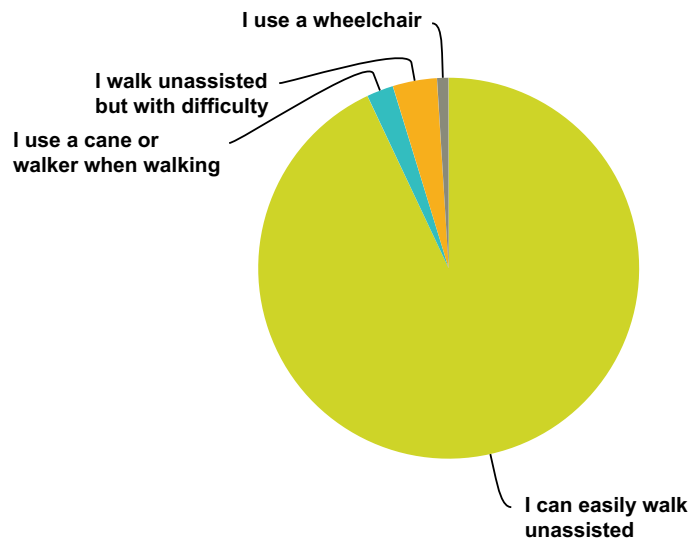

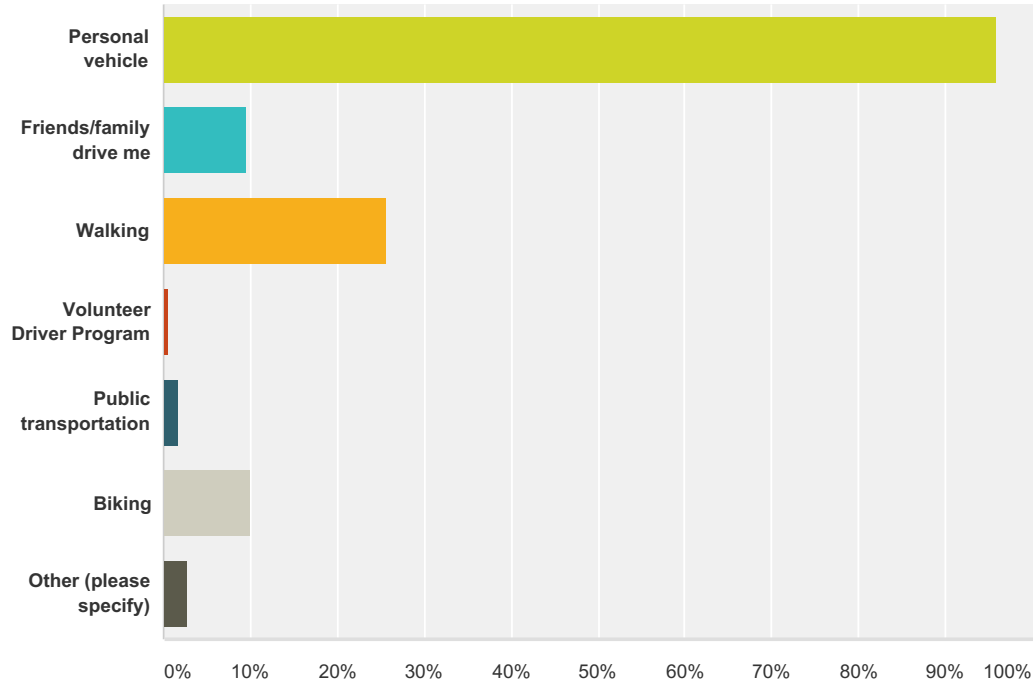

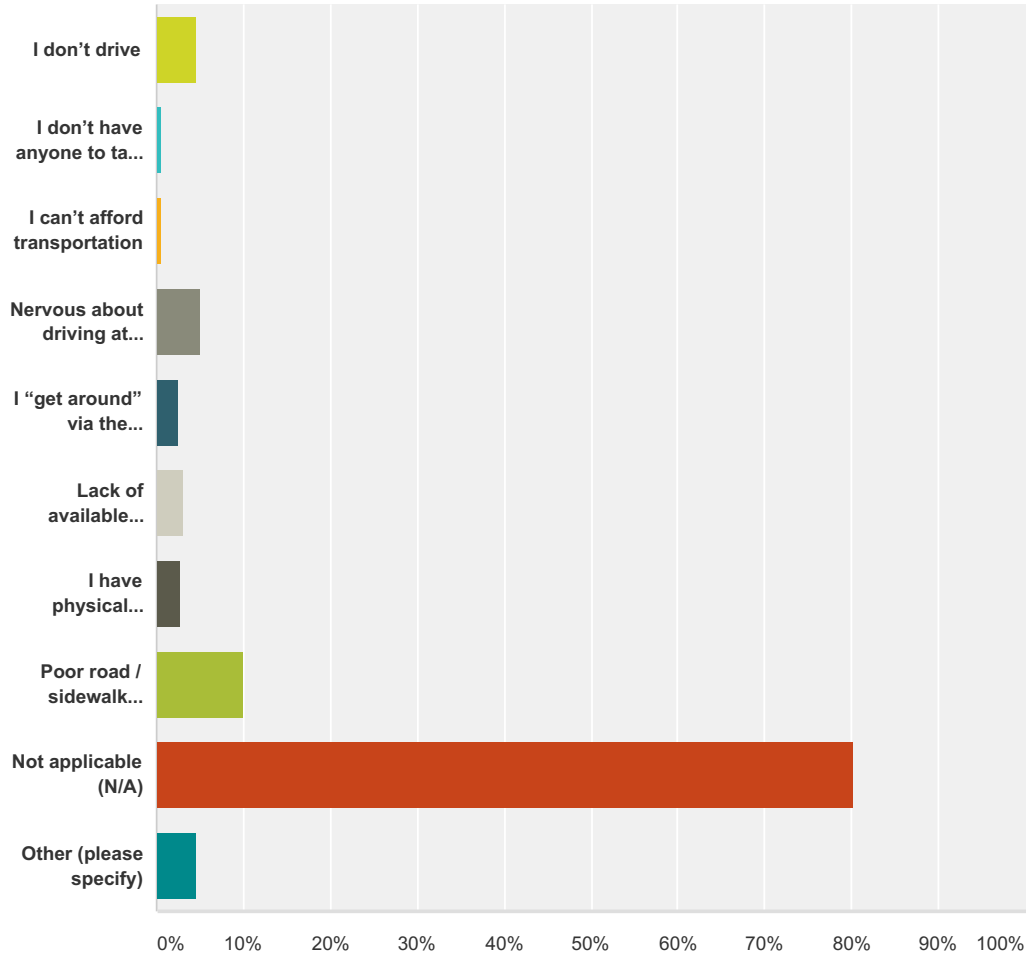

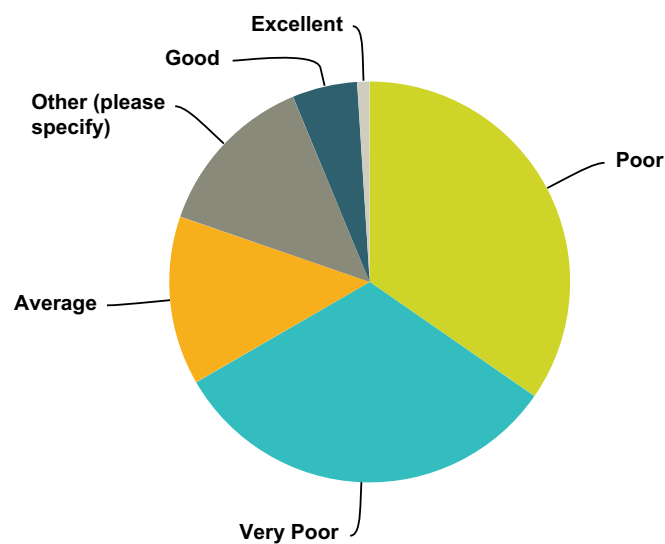

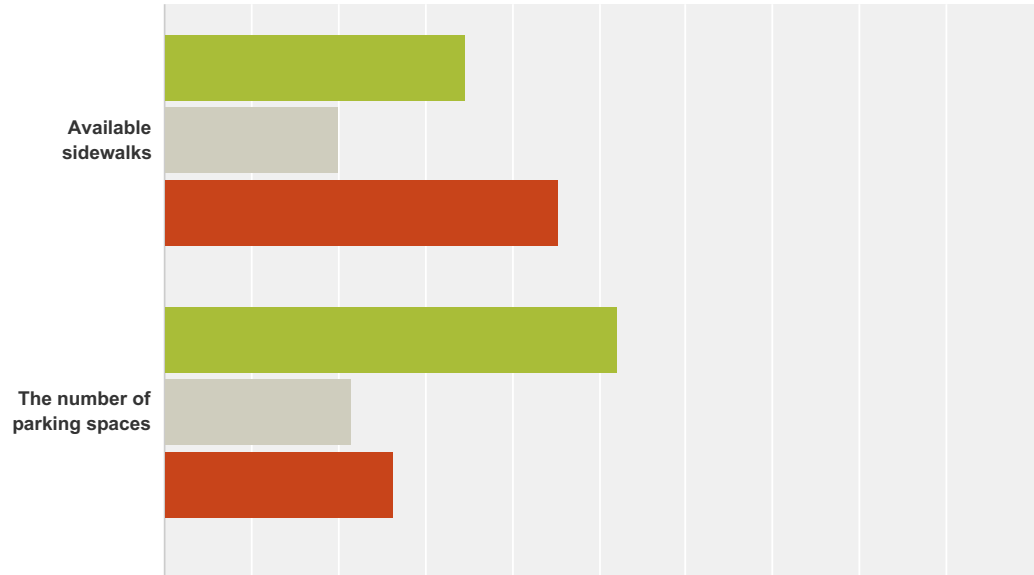

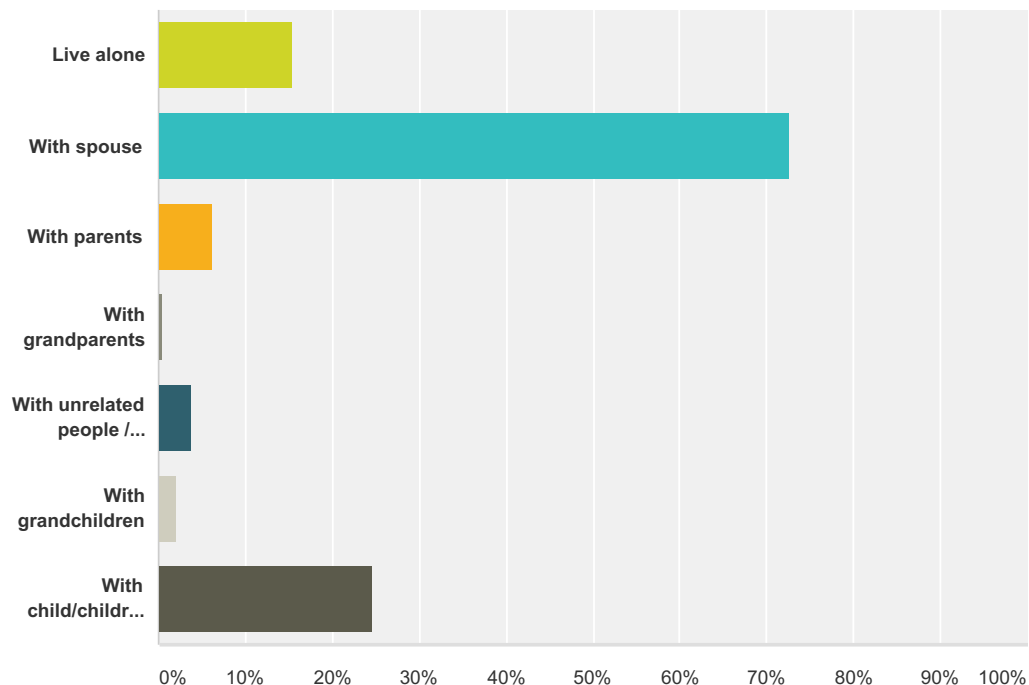

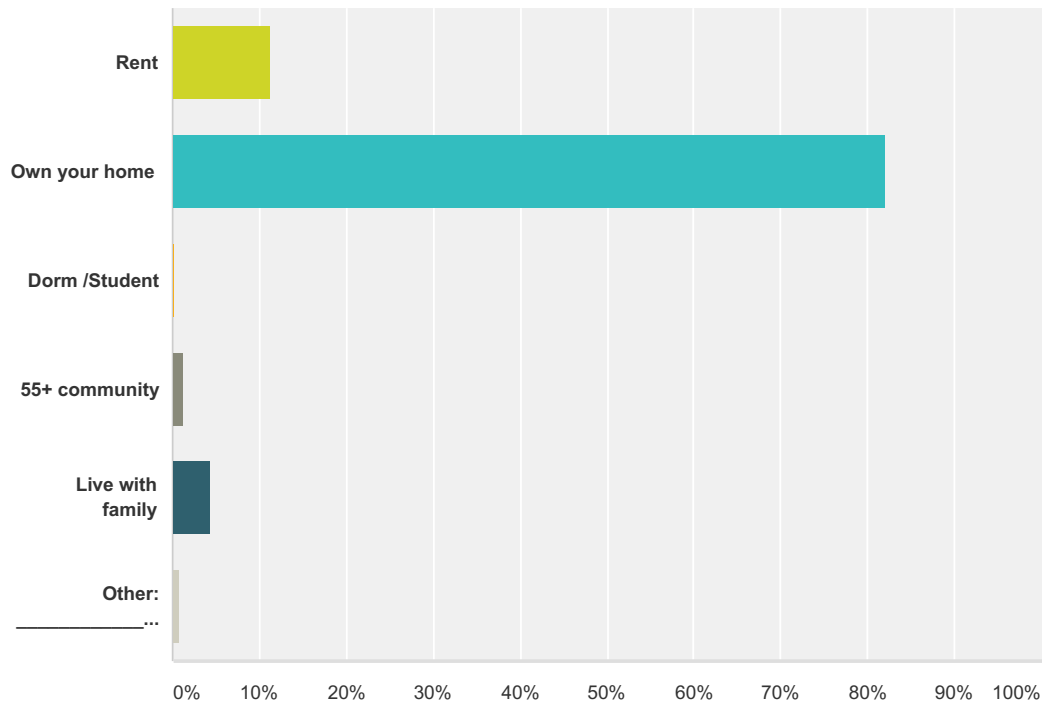

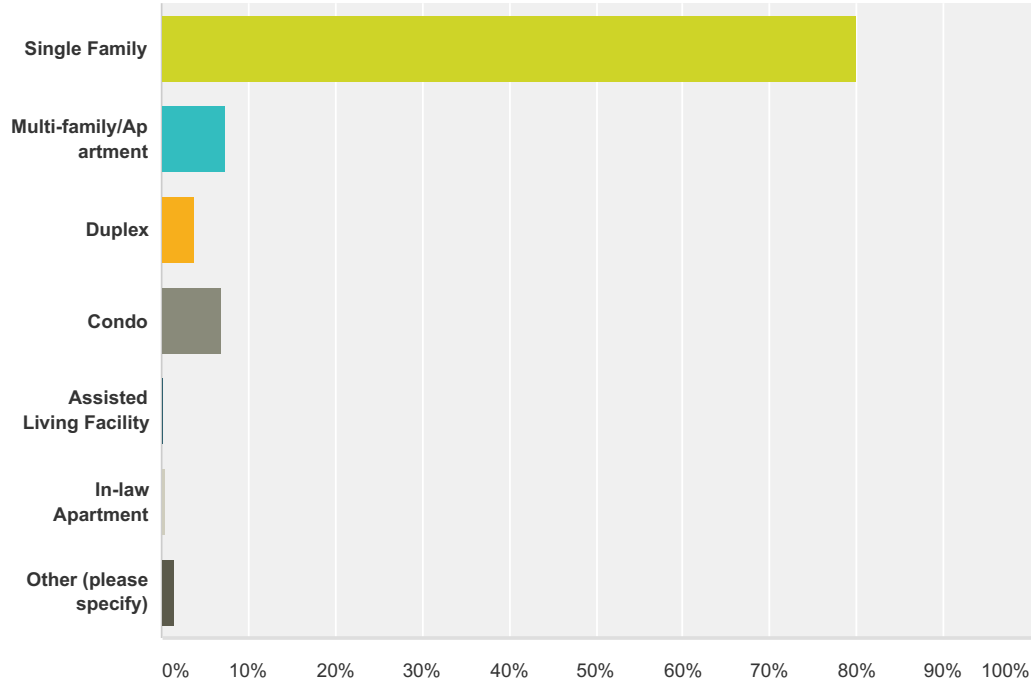

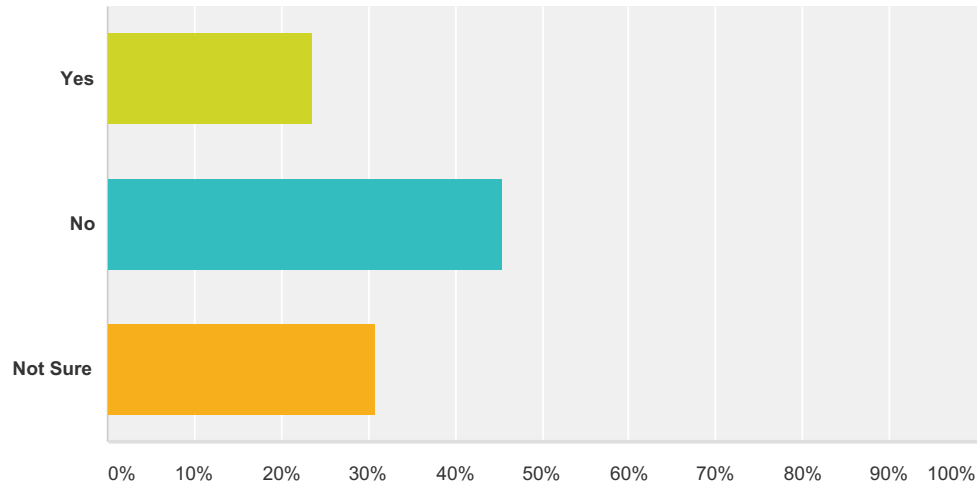

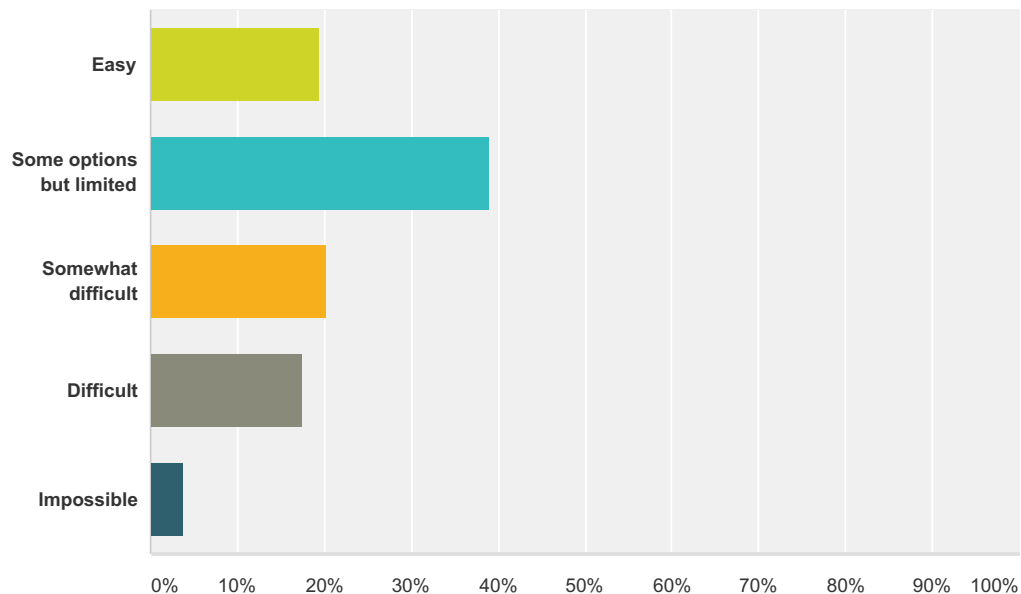

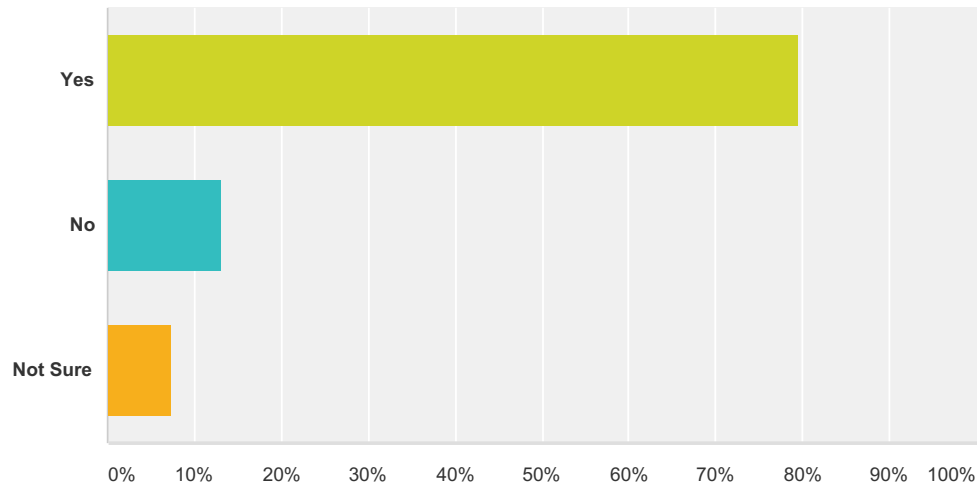

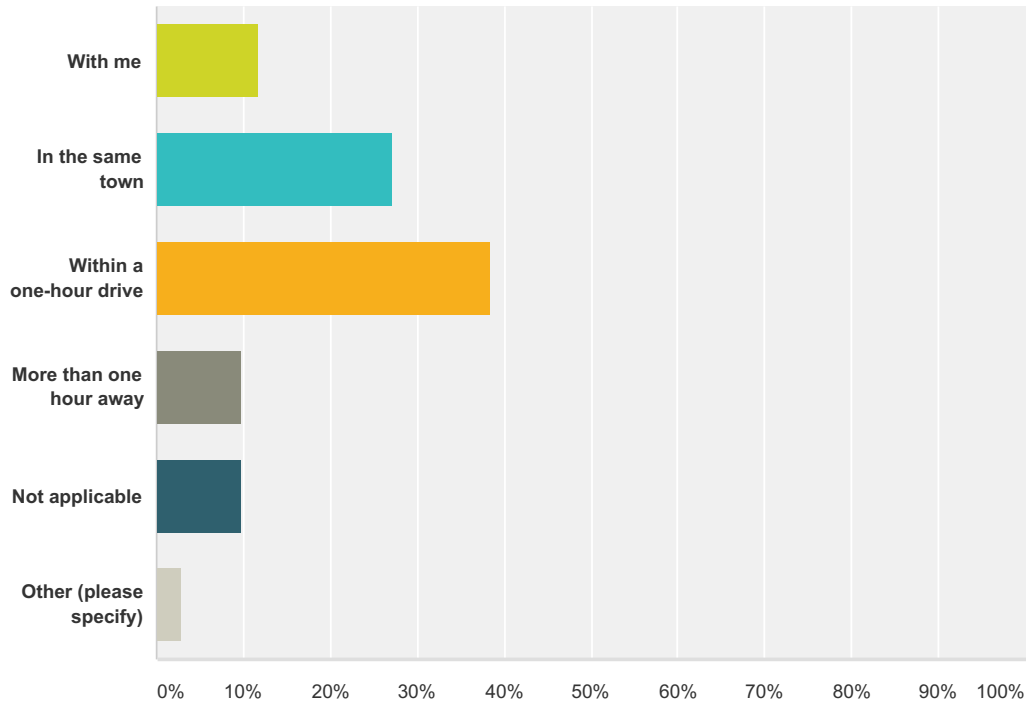

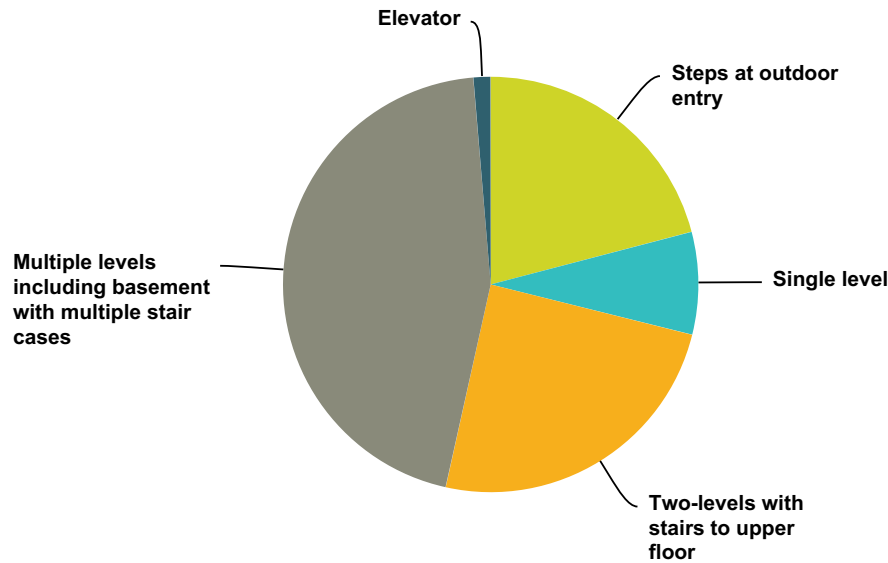

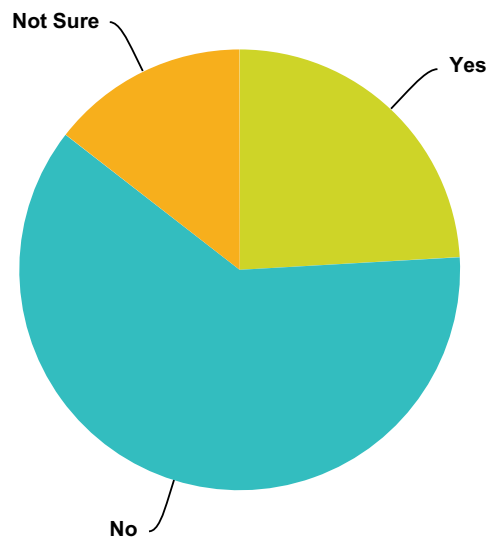

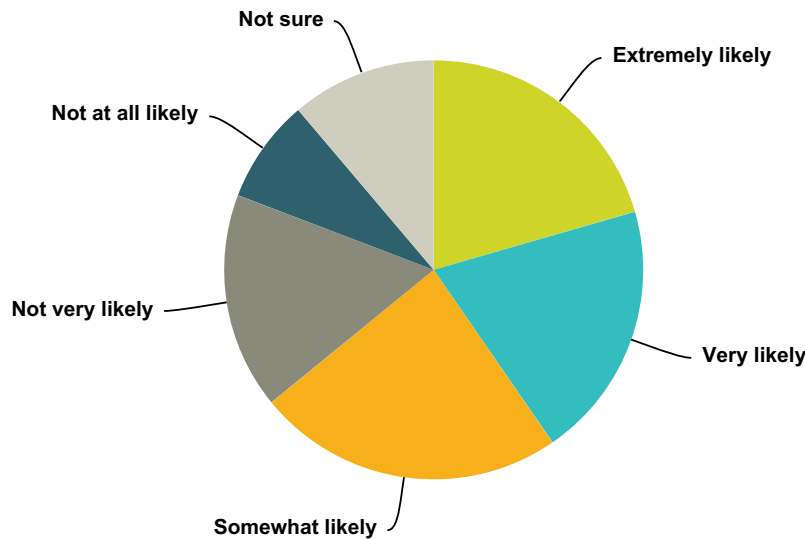

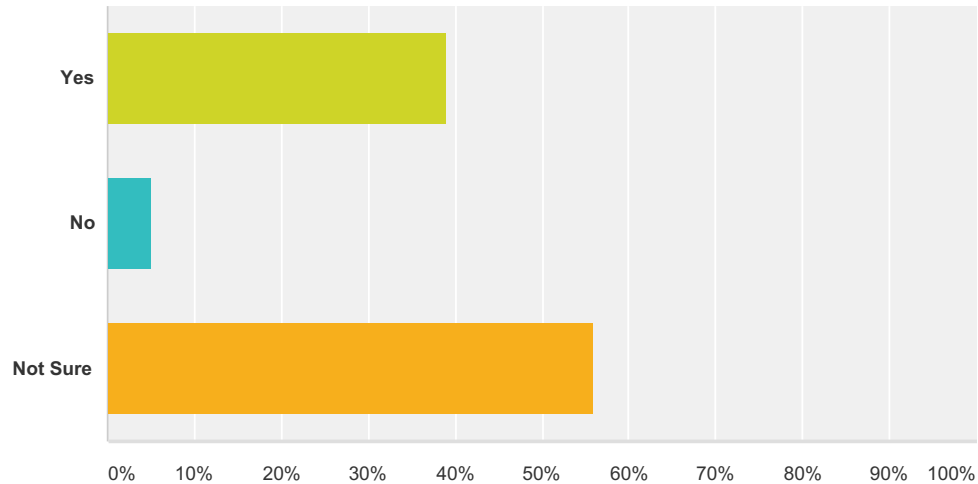

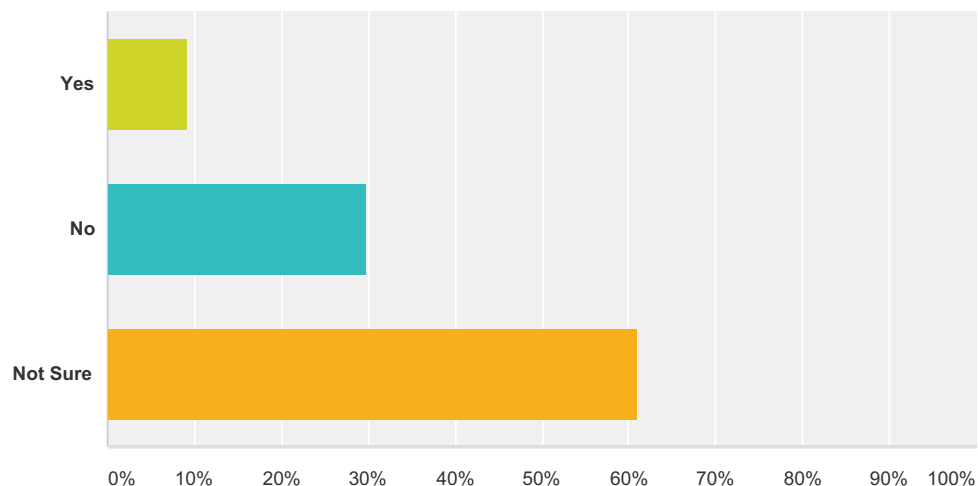

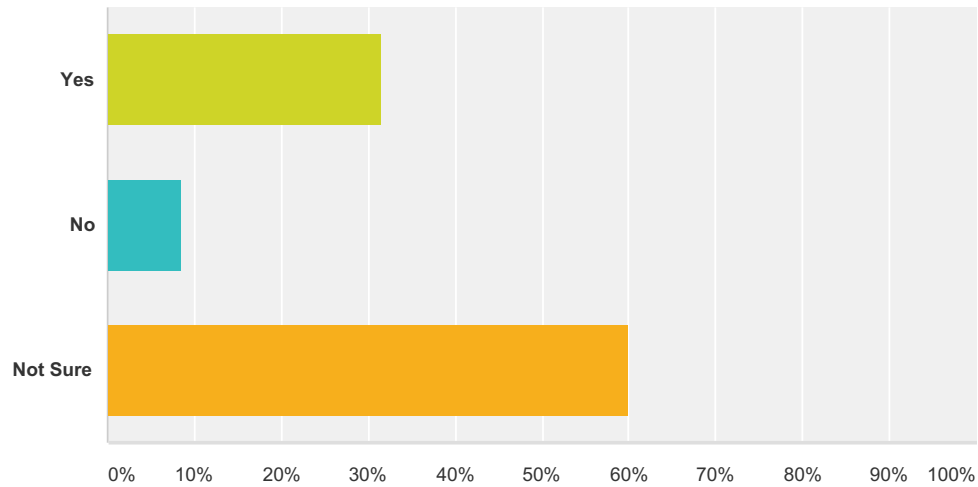

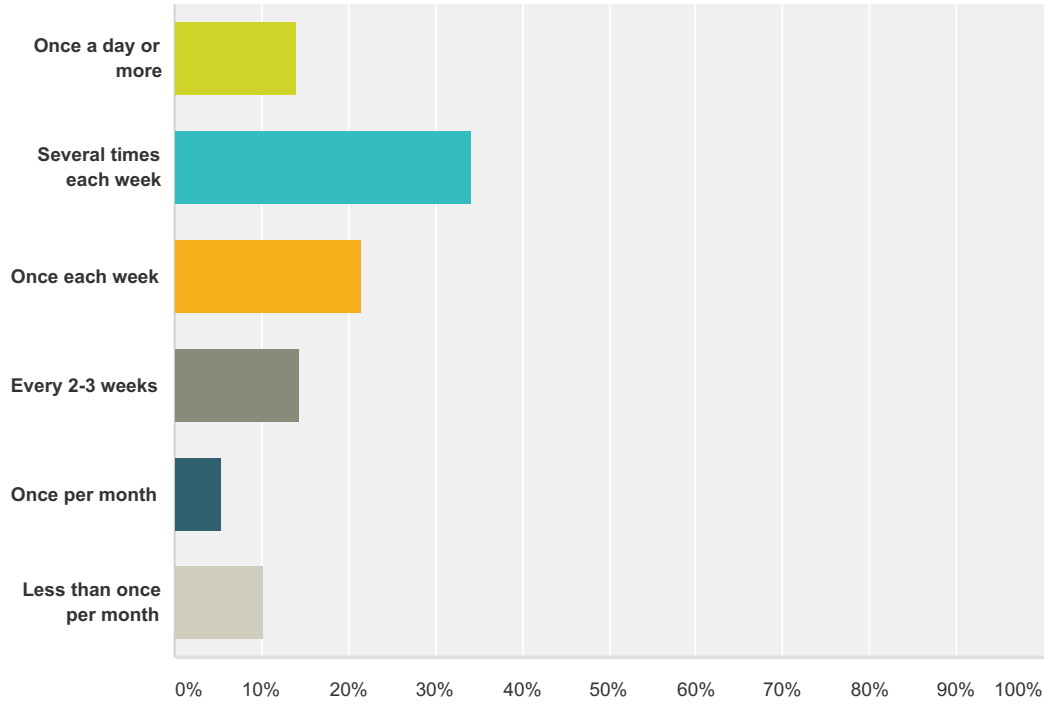

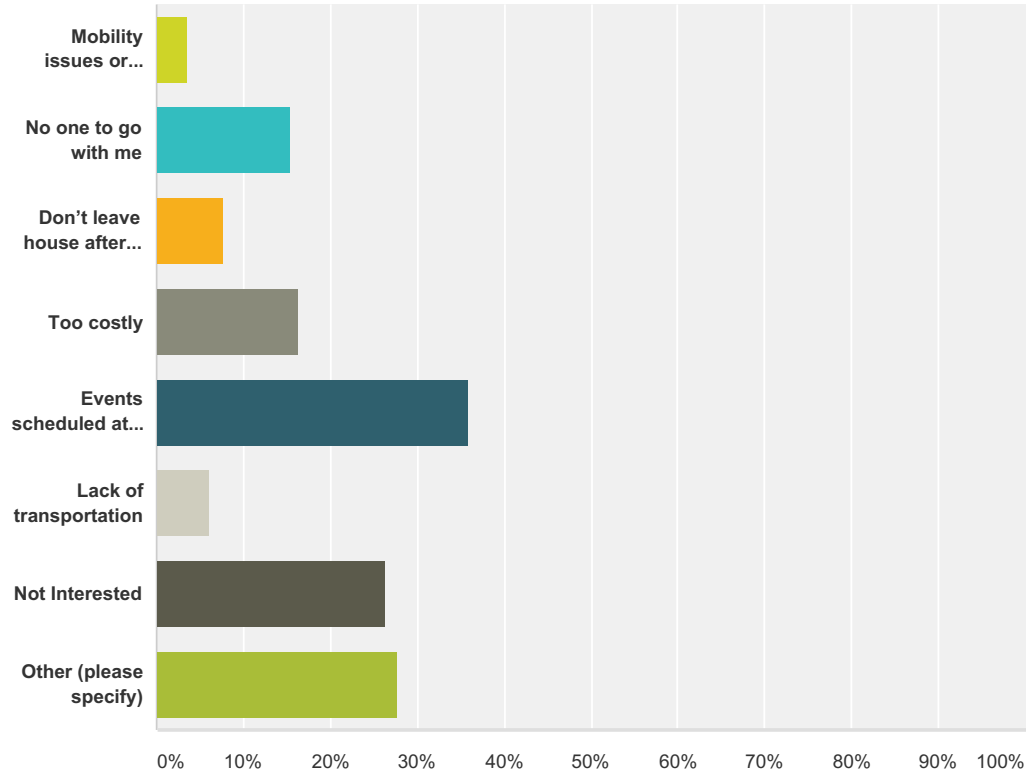

Q31 In your community, which of the following places or activities do you frequent?

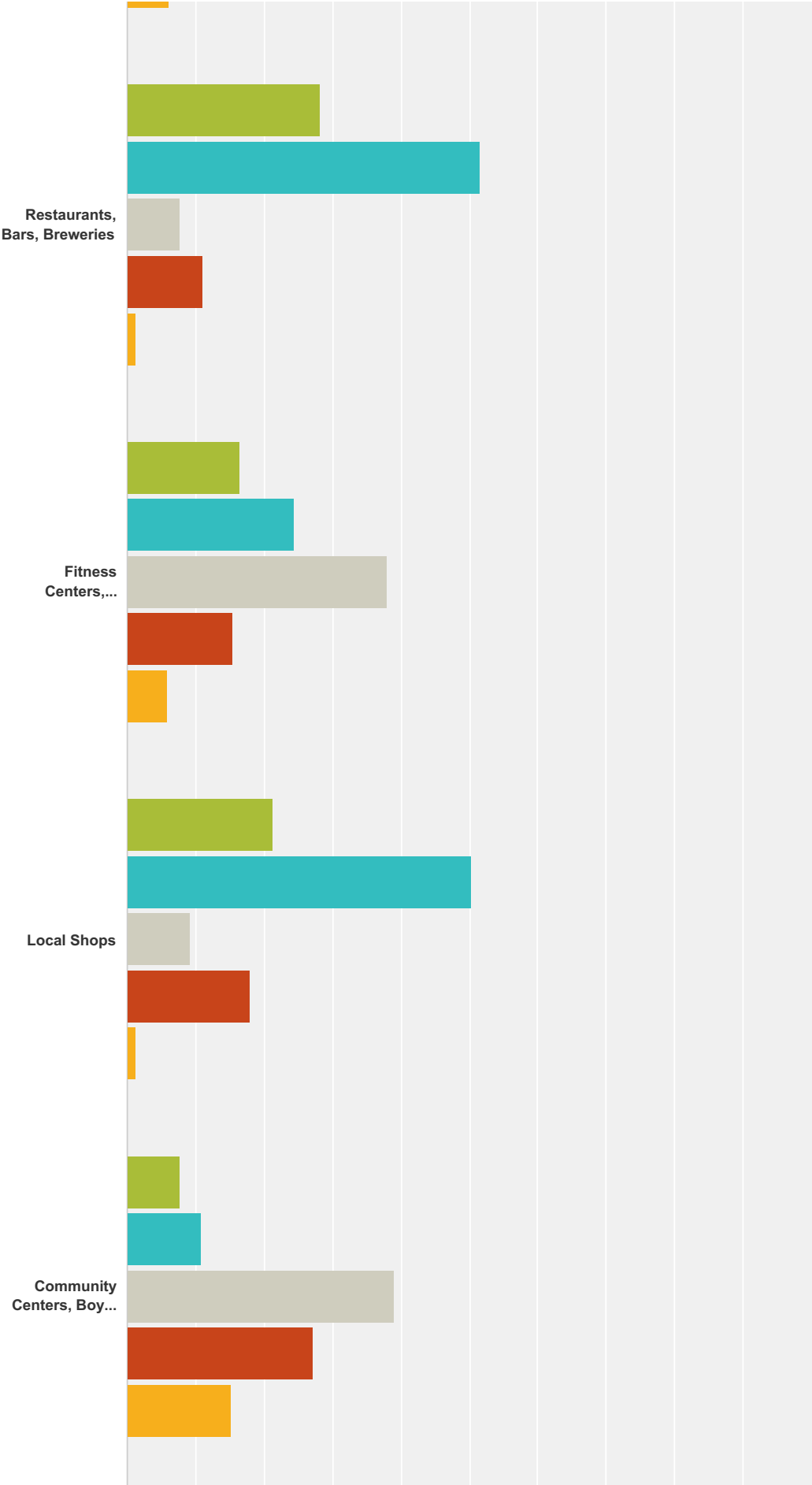

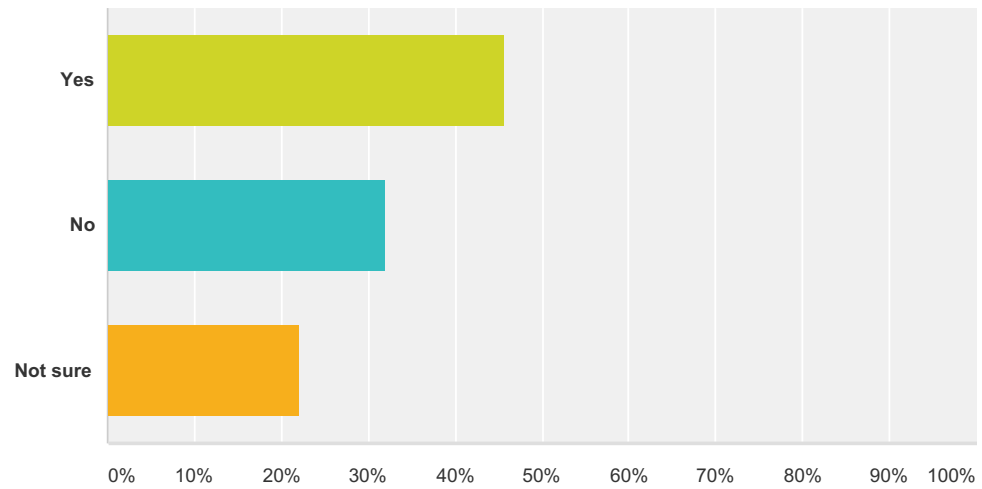

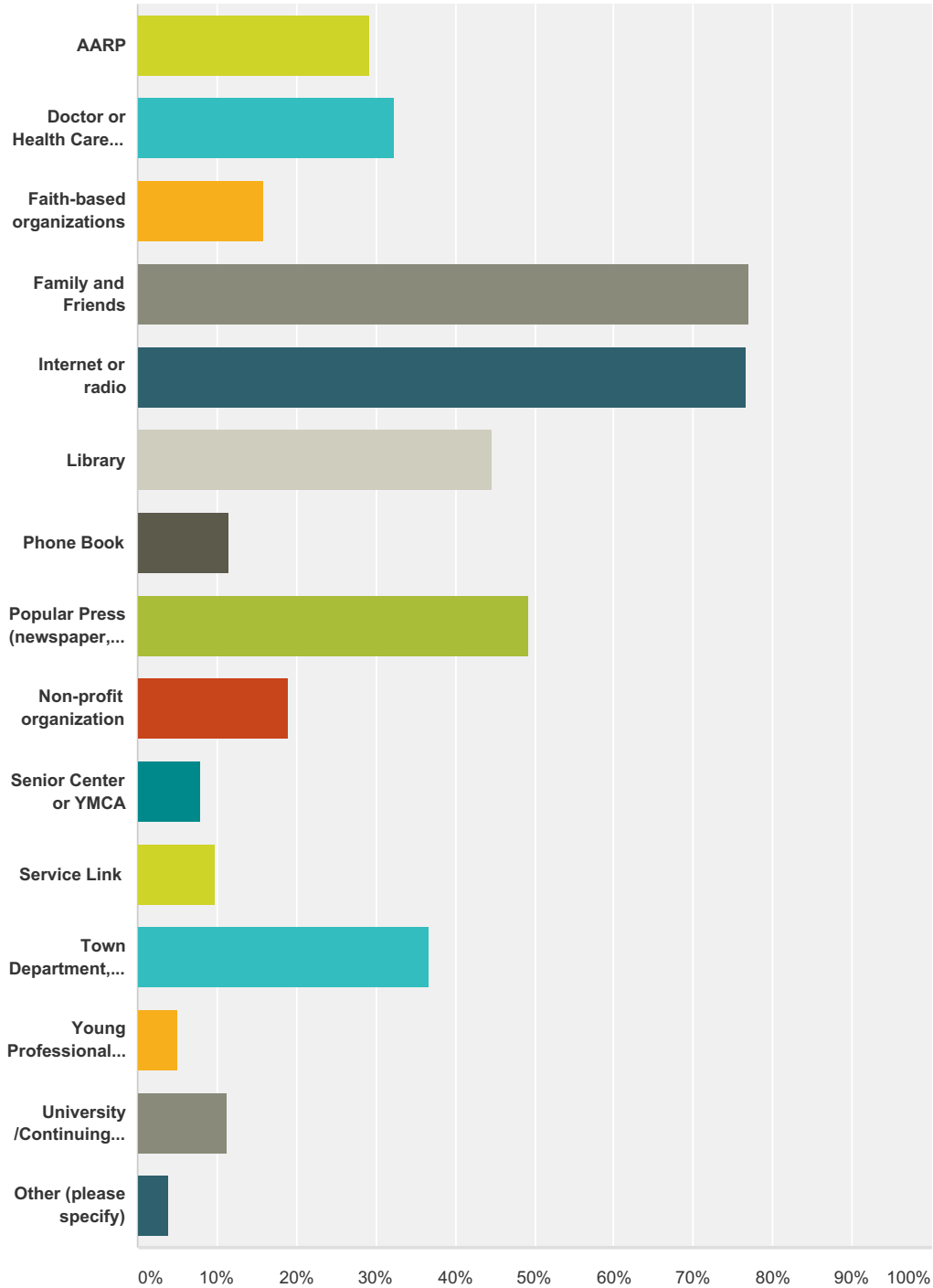

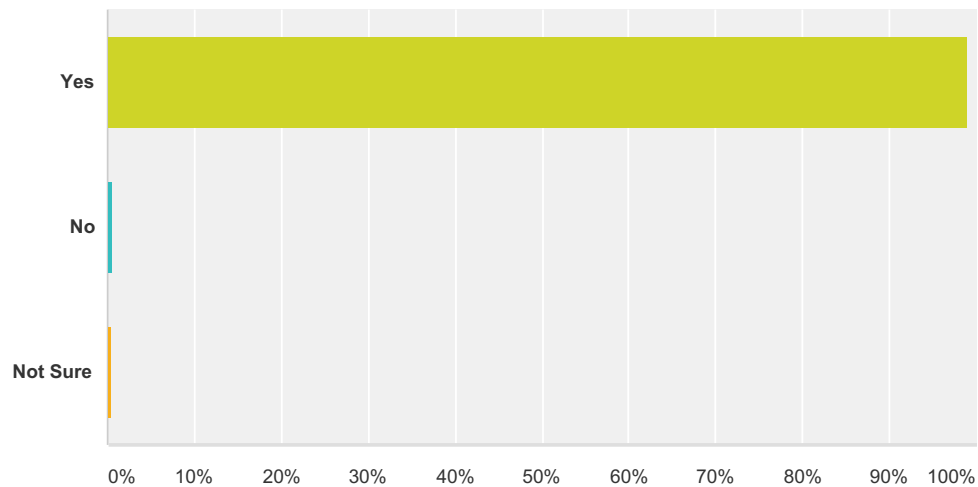

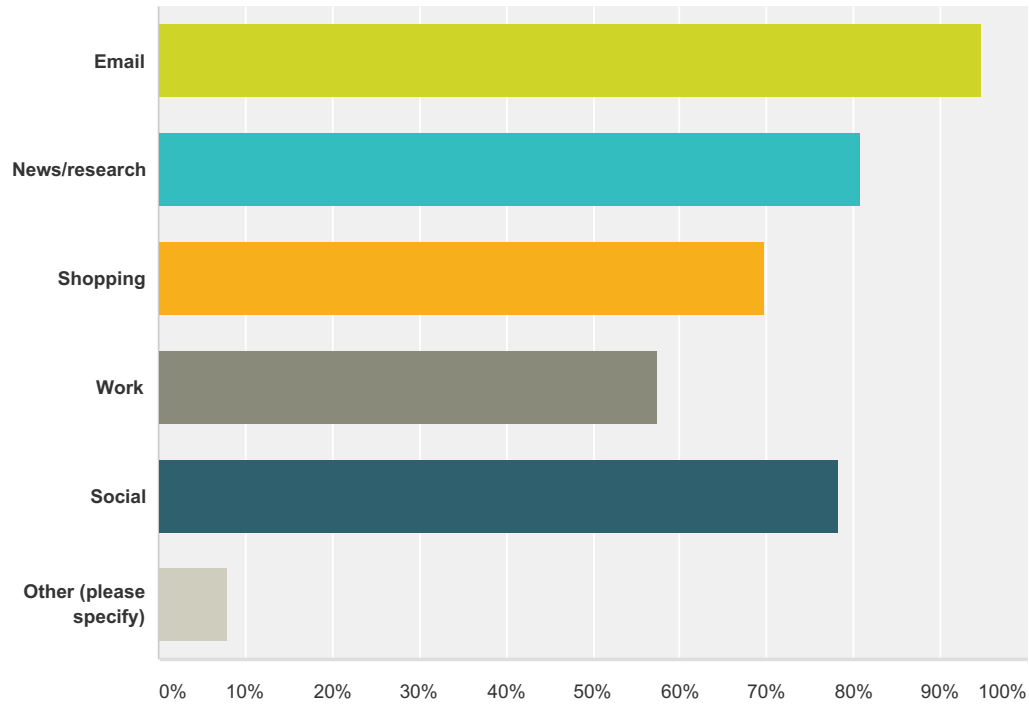

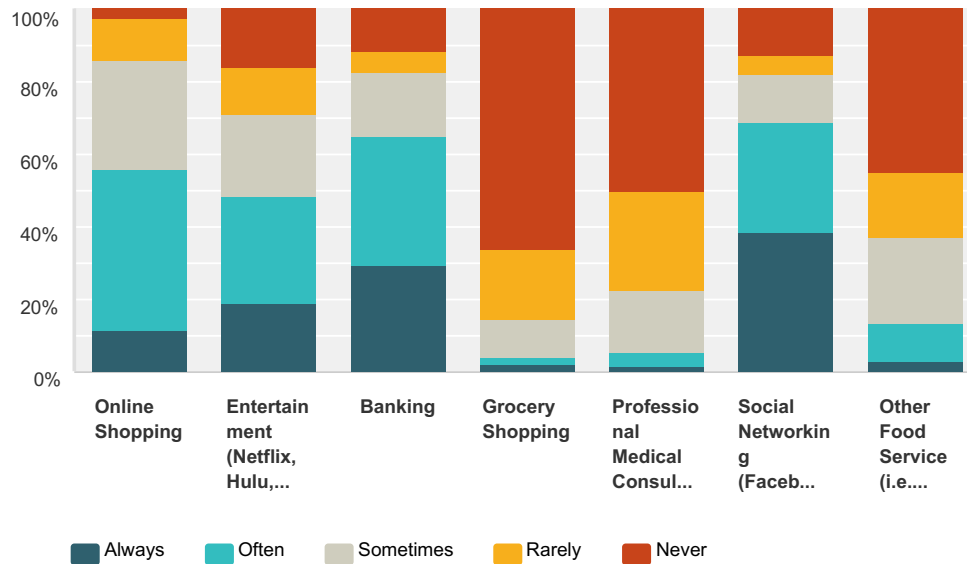
