

RSMS AT A GLANCE

What is RSMS?

Road Surface Management System is a program carried out by Southern NH Planning Commission (SNHPC) in collaboration with NHDOT and UNH Technology Transfer Center (T2).

SNHPC staff will assess the condition of your town's paved roads and provide a report detailing potential repair strategies, costs, and priorities.

What does the process look like?



WINDSHIELD SURVEY. SNHPC staff will inventory and assess pavement condition of all town-maintained roads in your community.



ANALYSIS. Inventory will be entered into Statewide RSMS software, which will generate potential repair strategies and prioritization.



MAPPING. SNHPC will map road conditions by 1/4 mile segment.



FOLLOW UP. SNHPC staff will hold a closeout meeting with town staff to discuss results and answer any questions.

How long does this all take?

The field portion takes about one day per 10 miles of town road. From start to finish, an RSMS project generally takes 6-9 months.
