

### About the Annual List of Obligated Projects



- In accordance with federal regulations (23 CFR §450.334), the SNHPC is required to "develop a listing of projects (including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities) for which funds under 23 U.S.C. or 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 were obligated in the preceding program year."
- FY 2019 in this context refers to October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019.



## FY 2019 SNHPC Annual List of Obligated Projects

- To make the report easier to read and understand, we have included additional information in the FY 2019 List of Obligated Projects, including:
  - An introductory narrative with a definition for each column heading in the report.
  - A categorization of each project in the list (e.g. highway, transit, bicycle/pedestrian, planning, research).
  - A description of whether each project was individually or programmatically listed in the TIP.



### FY 2019 SNHPC Annual List of Obligated Projects

#### Quick Facts about the FY 2019 Annual List of Obligated Projects

- There are 96 Projects listed in the report.
- The projects listed in the report include:
  - Nine (9) SNHPC Communities;
  - One (1) Manchester Urbanized Area community outside of the SNHPC Region (Bow); and
  - Sixty-two (62) Statewide Projects.
- Funding obligations in the SNHPC Region totaled \$48,153,585 in FY 2019 (approximately 16% of total statewide obligations).



#### FY 2019 SNHPC Annual List of Obligated Projects- By Category

- Total <u>Highway/Bridge</u> project obligations: \$34,809,810 (72.3% of obligations)
  - Obligations related for projects related to the I-93 expansion totaled \$20,175,532 in FY 2019.
- Total <u>Transit</u> project obligations: \$4,047,635 (8.4% of obligations)
- Total <u>Bicycle/Pedestrian</u> project obligations: \$2,084,163 (4.3% of obligations)
  - This figure includes only standalone bicycle/pedestrian projects, not portions of highway/bridge projects that might include bicycle/pedestrian infrastructure.
- Total <u>Planning</u> project obligations: \$6,514,283 (13.5% of obligations)
- Total <u>Research</u> project obligations: \$697,694 (1.4% of obligations)
