 Incorporate language noting the that a portion of the Manchester Urbanized Area extends into the towns of Allenstown, Bow, and Pembroke. As such, the SNHPC and CNHRPC coordinate on both project-level and planning-level public outreach efforts for the Manchester UZA.

Comments Received – Performance Measures

• **SUMMARY OF COMMENT(S)**:

 Performance measures should be easily quantifiable with minimal subjectivity. "Produce informative, effective, and userfriendly materials [...]" is largely subjective and difficult to defensibly quantify as a performance measure.

<u>RECOMMENDED RESPONSE:</u>

• Concur with this comment and remove the performance measure.

 Add information to the plan about how the SNHPC will facilitate translation services for persons with Limited English Proficiency, or interpretation services for deaf, hard of hearing, and blind persons when needed.
