FY 2023-2026 SNHPC Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

- The draft SNHPC FY 2023-2026 TIP was released for public review and comment on January 19, 2023. A 30-day comment period started on January 19, 2023 and will continue through February 20, 2023.
 - **NHDOT has submitted comments for consideration. No other comments have been received to date.**
- Staff provided a detailed presentation about the draft TIP at the January 19, 2023 SNHPC TAC meeting.
- The SNHPC MPO will hold a public hearing to consider adoption of the TIP on February 21, 2023.



Comments Received on the Draft FY 2023-2026 TIP

- NHDOT has submitted comments to all four MPOs, some of which are applicable to the draft SNHPC FY 2023-2026 TIP. The comments include:
 - Individually listing Candia-Raymond Project #43839.
 - Adding additional funds to the PAVE-T1-RESURF program to accommodate the Candia-Raymond Project.
 - Making non-substantive technical corrections to the scope descriptions to six projects (Bow 29641, Candia 41592, Derry-Londonderry 13065B, Manchester 43826, Wilton-Milford-Amherst-Bedford 13692D and 13692E.)



Comments Received on the Draft FY 2023-2026 TIP

- **Candia-Raymond (43839)**
 - Scope of Work: Rehabilitation/Reconstruction of a Section of NH Route 101
 - Total Funding in Draft TIP: \$2,452,296
 - Construction Schedule: Start in FY 2024
 - Changes: Project will now be funded by two different statewide programs and will need to be individually-listed in the TIP.
