The SNHPC's Approach to the FY 2023-2032 Ten-Year Plan

- The SNHPC focused on adding supplemental funding to existing, underfunded projects in the SNHPC region to ensure that the projects are completed on schedule.
 - Bedford (40664) U.S. Route 3 Widening from Hawthorne Drive North to Manchester Airport Access Road
 - Londonderry (41593) Safety and Operational Improvements at the Intersection of NH Route 28/NH Route 128

Both projects are fully funded in the draft Ten-Year Plan.



TAP Projects in the FY 2023-2032 Ten-Year Plan

- NHDOT has announced awards for Round 4 of the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP), and the recommended projects are included in the draft TYP.
- The SNHPC Region's #1 and #2 priority TAP projects were funded:
 - **Derry -** Construct a 1,900 LF extension of the Derry Rail Trail between Madden Road and the Londonderry town line
 - Manchester Construct a 4,800 LF Multi-use Path adjacent to Canal Street between Granite Street and Brook Street.



Turnpike System Projects in the FY 2023-2032 Ten-Year Plan

- Manchester (16099A) Reconstruction of I-293 Exit 6
 - Delayed 4 years due to reduced toll revenue forecasts. The project will be now be scheduled for 2029-2032.
- Manchester (16099B) Reconstruction of I-293 Exit 7
 - Delayed 3 years due to reduced toll revenue forecasts. The project will be now be scheduled for 2027-2029.
- Nashua-Merrimack-Bedford (13761) Widening of F.E. Everett Turnpike from Exit 8 in Nashua to I-293 in Bedford
 - The completion of this project to be delayed 3 years due to reduced toll revenue forecasts. The project will be now be scheduled for 2022-2028.



Regional Public Transportation Needs in the FY 2023-2032 Ten-Year Plan





- The SNHPC supports the transfer of
 \$800K per year of Surface
 Transportation Block Grant (STBG)
 funding to support the Section 5310
 Purchase of Service program for elderly
 and disabled transportation (including
 CART's Derry-Londonderry Shuttle).
- The SNHPC supports the transfer of 25% of Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) program funding to support public transportation capital and operating needs statewide.



Other Regional Needs Not Addressed in the FY 2023-2032 Ten-Year Plan

- A number of important regional projects are not addressed in the FY 2023-2032 Ten-Year Plan. The SNHPC will work with communities to secure funding for these projects through the next Ten-Year Plan process or other programmatic opportunities.
 - **Deerfield** Convert Intersection of NH Route 107/Candia Road/Church Street to a Roundabout
 - Hooksett NH Route 3A Corridor Study
 - Manchester I-293/Second Street Engineering Study
 - Manchester I-93 Exit 8 Interchange Improvements
 - Manchester Intersection Improvements at Hooksett Road/Campbell Street and Campbell Street/Hamel Drive



GACIT Hearing Update

- Two Governor's Advisory Commission on Intermodal Transportation (GACIT) hearings have been held in the SNHPC region to date.
 - Londonderry (9/22/21)
 - Manchester (9/28/21)
- Londonderry GACIT Hearing Summary
 - Hearing was lightly attended.
 - Londonderry Town Manager Kevin Smith spoke in support of the projects programmed in the Town of Londonderry.
 - Londonderry Resident Ray Breslin spoke in opposition to the Exit 4A project due to environmental and water quality concerns.



GACIT Hearing Update

- Manchester GACIT Hearing Summary
 - Hearing was moderately attended (15-20 in person with an additional 5-10 participating remotely).
 - Multiple comments were received expressing general support for bicycle/pedestrian infrastructure projects, and encouraging NHDOT to enhance focus on bicycle/pedestrian infrastructure in the TYP.
 - Multiple comments were received expressing disappointment about the delays to the Turnpike projects in Manchester and encouraging NHDOT to complete those projects expeditiously.
 - Hooksett Town Administrator Andre Garron spoke about needs on the NH Route 3A Corridor and Hackett Hill area.
